Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this ordinance is to authorize one-time carryover in calendar year 2018 of vacation hours in excess of the two year limitation for two employees: Carolyn Glass and Mark Deeb. As principal team members on the City's Data Center Move project these employees have been unable to utilize their accrued vacation for the last two years.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Upon approval by City Council, Carolyn Glass will be able to carry over approximately 139 vacation hours in excess of the 24-month accrual. Mark Deeb will be able to carry over approximately 146 vacation hours in excess of the 24-month accrual.
