

**ORDINANCE No.** 188718

Authorize a contract with lowest responsible bidder for the SW Vermont Street: SW 65<sup>th</sup> to SW Capitol Hwy Pavement Rehabilitation Project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On May 17th, 2016, Portland voters passed Measure 26-173, Portland's first local funding source dedicated to fixing our streets. Measure 26-173 will raise an estimated \$64 million over four years. This is the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) Fixing Our Street Program.
2. As part of the Fixing Our Streets program, PBOT will construct pavement maintenance work on SW Vermont Street from SW 65<sup>th</sup> Ave to SW Capitol Hwy; install sidewalk on the south side of SW Vermont from SW 46<sup>th</sup> to SW 52<sup>nd</sup>; widen the shoulder along the north side of Vermont west of 52<sup>nd</sup>; add bike lanes east of 52<sup>nd</sup>; update and/or install ADA ramps to meet current ADA standards; construct multi-use sidewalk between 52<sup>nd</sup> and 50<sup>th</sup>; and add marked pedestrian and bike crossings.
3. The pavement condition on SW Vermont Street has deteriorated to a point at which a minimum of 3-inch grind and overlay and full-depth repair of some sections are required.
4. Grinding and paving 3 inches meets PBOT's Pavement Management strategy of performing pavement maintenance earlier in the pavement lifecycle to prevent much higher rehabilitation costs in the future.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, as the project scope is clearly understood and well defined.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to PBOT T00588 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


