ORDINANCE NO.

* Authorize application and accept a grant in the amount of \$75,057 and appropriate \$60,000 for FY 2017-18 from Oregon Impact's Driving Under the Influence High Visibility Enforcement program for sworn overtime reimbursement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Oregon Impact has notified the City that it will award a grant for the Federal Fiscal Year 2018 (FFY18) DUII HVE Grant in the amount of \$75,057.36;
- 2. The Police Bureau wishes to apply for and accept the Oregon Impact grant award;
- Oregon Impact will reimburse the City the verified average officer/sergeant overtime rate of \$72.73 per hour for the Traffic Division's direct enforcement of reducing impaired driving and improving traffic safety;
- Oregon Impact requires that agencies receiving funds participate in two National Highway Traffic Safety Administration pre-determined HVE national events with Oregon Association of Chiefs of Police and the Oregon State Police: Christmas 2017/New Year 2018 and Labor Day 2018;
- 5. The local match may include any agency resources used to support the overtime activity, including scheduling and report compilation, as well as straight-time enforcement. Local match shall be provided from City funds in the form of Traffic Division straight time hours in support of DUII enforcement in the Police Bureau's existing General Fund appropriation. The estimated minimum match is \$98,563;
- 6. The grant period runs through September 30, 2018; and
- 7. The Council declares that an emergency exists due to critical dates in the project timeline as required by the grant.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to make application to Oregon Impact in a form similar to the application attached as Exhibit A for a grant in the amount of \$75,057.36.
- b. The Chief of Police is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.

- c. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from Oregon Impact for the FFY18 DUII HVE grant program in the amount of \$75,057.36.
- d. The FY 2017-18 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217

Business Area - PL

Bureau Program Expenses - \$60,000

- e. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Chief and Mayor's behalves.
- f. The Chief of the Police is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by Oregon Impact DUII HVE grant program provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists due to critical dates in the project timeline as required by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
