ORDINANCE No. 188727

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University to provide funding not to exceed \$15,000 for a Graduate Research Assistant (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The purpose of this Intergovernmental Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is to establish the terms and conditions of cooperative interaction between PSU and the City to provide funding for a Graduate Research Assistant.
- 2. Collaboration with PSU on selecting and funding Graduate Research Assistants benefits the City through research and project assistance from a qualified Master of Urban and Regional Planning students with diverse experiences and perspectives to further integrate long range land use planning and equity goals.
- 3. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability has identified advancing funding and partnership opportunities for a targeted internship program for diverse students in Long Term Goal in 2 in the Bureau Racial Equity Plan.
- 4. This IGA advances Citywide Racial Equity Goals. This IGA for coordination between the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability and Portland State University to fund Graduate Research Assistant positions through the Diversity Scholarship. This IGA is supported by the Office of Equity and Human Rights Strategy Five of the Citywide Racial Equity Strategy by partnering with communities and institutions to achieve meaningful results.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Portland State University in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Attachment 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for this grant chargeable to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, Cost Object PNCP000001.
- c. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is hereby authorized to sign amendments for continuing data management, reporting and funding in future fiscal years if appropriations are approved by City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to forward funds for services to continue work that benefits the City. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
