

ORDINANCE No. 188739

*Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the SE 122nd Ave: Johnson Creek Bridge Replacement Project for an estimated \$2,057,748 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Transportation is responsible for the operation and maintenance of public transportation infrastructure.
2. The Bureau of Transportation seeks Council's authorization for Procurement Services to issue a competitive solicitation and execute a contract for S.E. 122nd Ave: Johnson Creek Bridge Replacement Project.
3. The Project is required to replace the storm-damaged bridge that carries public traffic on SE 122nd Avenue over Johnson Creek. A grant from the Federal Highway Bridge Program to replace the bridge was accepted by Ordinance No. 187976 on September 7, 2016.
4. The weatherworn timber bridge that carries public traffic on SE 122nd Avenue over Johnson Creek in the Pleasant Valley Neighborhood was significantly damaged by the record-breaking storms in December of 2015. The bridge was closed to all motorized vehicular traffic on February 3, 2016, and remains so.
5. The engineer's estimate for this contract action is \$2,057,748.07.
6. The Bureau's confidence level in the estimated cost is High.
7. Funding of \$2,057,784.07 is available in the FY 18/19 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in accordance with City Code for the purchase of construction services for the SE 122nd Ave: Johnson Creek Bridge Replacement Project.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report recommending the contract award, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.


- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Transportation Operating Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the solicitation would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the ordinance; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


