ORDINANCE No. 188748

*Authorize a grant agreement with Fresh Out in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for their community based re-entry program that provides services to recently incarcerated African-Americans living in Portland (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Since 2007, Fresh Out has been assisting African-American men and women transition back into the community after periods of incarceration. Their community based re-entry program provides a wide variety of services to help ensure individual stability and enhanced support, to make the transition from incarceration back into the community, somewhat easier.
- 2. Fresh Out provides referral and support services to help reduce recidivism in African-American men and women. These services include but are not limited to short-term rental assistance, utility assistance, employment support, treatment facilitation and referral, gang intervention, and mental health treatment and referral. Since their inception, Fresh Out has worked with over a 1000 people.
- 3. African-Americans are over-represented in both the correctional system and the homeless population, recidivism is high among this demographic. Fresh Out's mission is to help combat these problems, through their community based re-entry program.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, with Fresh Out, a. as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$50,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could result in a delay in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
