## **ORDINANCE No.** 188759

\* Accept a grant from the Oregon Office of Emergency Management for their Emergency Management Performance Grant Program in the amount of \$290,614 to administer an integrated all-hazard emergency management program for the City (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Office of Emergency Management's Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) Program provides financial and technical assistance through their FY 17/18 grant for the development of an all-hazard emergency management capability to promote planning, response, exercise, training and community outreach.
- 2. Grant funds support staff salaries and benefits, rent, and technology services for established bureau programs.
- 3. City of Portland matching funds up to the amount of \$290,614 shall be in the form of salary, benefits, and technology services in the FY17/18 budget of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland an Emergency Management Agency Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) program in the amount of \$290,614 and to execute the award.
- b. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- c. The Director of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications to the EMPG grant, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay is likely to impair the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


