### Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division has notified the City that it will award a grant for the 2018 Speed Enforcement Grant Program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$15,000. The City was awarded the ODOT Speed Enforcement Grant in 2017; the funds were used to defray the personnel costs associated with educating drivers on speed laws, and with the enforcement of speed laws.

Portland Police Bureau officers and sergeants will again be reimbursed for overtime worked on speed enforcement at top speed involved crash locations within the City as determined by the ODOT Transportation Safety Division. These locations include portions of 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, 122<sup>nd</sup>, SE Powell, Division, Foster Road, NE Marine Drive, Lombard, Burnside, Sandy, and SW Barbur, among others.

## Financial and budgetary impacts:

The total grant award is \$15,000, which will be divided between Fiscal Year 2018 and Fiscal Year 2019. At this time, the City will appropriate \$7,500 into the Grant Fund for Fiscal Year 2018 and \$7,500 for Fiscal Year 2019. This grant comes with a straight-time match obligation of \$3,750.07 which will be funded by the Police Bureau's General Fund appropriation.

## Community impacts and community involvement:
