Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Oregon State Marine Board (OSMB) Maintenance Assistance Program (MAP) has provided a continuing grant that is allocated annually to the City of Portland's Bureau of Parks and Recreation (PP&R) for maintenance of qualifying boating facilities. An ordinance is required to accept this, or any, grant award.

The Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to execute the same form of agreement in any following year in which funds from this grant are available, provided that the City of Portland, Parks Allocation Certification Agreement Maintenance Assistance Program for each fiscal year is approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The acceptance of the \$19,950 grant for FY2017-18 will not generate or reduce future revenue. The FY2017-18 grant amount is already budgeted. However, the City will be able to accept grant funds that will be used for the maintenance of qualifying boating facilities in the City of Portland.
