

ORDINANCE No. 188797

* Amend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to extend the Sex Buyers Accountability and Diversion Program through December 31, 2018 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002122)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland (City) and Multnomah County (County) are committed to addressing the problem of commercial sex and human trafficking in the region;
2. The Sex Buyers Accountability and Diversion Program (SBAD) offers education for persons arrested for solicitation of prostitution about the legal, social, and health ramifications of the commercial sex trade;
3. The County contracts with Lifeworks Northwest to provide assistance in the design, development and implementation of the SBAD program;
4. This amendment will extend the term of the Intergovernmental Agreement through December 31, 2018; and
5. Council declares an emergency exists because the current Intergovernmental Agreement term expires on December 31, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor is authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No. 30002122 between the City and Multnomah County as outlined in a form similar to the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police and the Project Manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of annual compensation or increase the City's financial risk.


