## ORDINANCE No. 188811

\*Authorize a grant agreement with Lewis and Clark College in an amount not to exceed \$35,000 to support the Community Response and Supportive Engagement with those Targeted by Hate and Bias project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Graduate School of Education and Counseling (GSEC) at the Lewis and Clark
  College is deeply committed to social justice, and seeks to fulfill that mission through
  service to the Portland Metropolitan community and beyond through programs such
  as Center for Community Engagement and Community Counseling Center.
- The Center for Community Engagement enhances the effectiveness of education and mental health professionals as agents of change by providing equity driven professional development.
- 3. The Community Counseling Center at Lewis and Clark College GSEC wants to expand culturally appropriate and socially just services to those impacted by hate and bias, report hate-related calls and services, and expand outreach.
- 4. The FY2017-18 budget includes funding in the General Fund Special Appropriations for the Portland United Against Hate (PUAH) program. Lewis and Clark College was selected through competitive process as one of the twelve awardees to receive funds for PUAH projects.
- 5. The City now desires to make a grant to Lewis and Clark College in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the Lewis and Clark College, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$35,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding will affect the Lewis and Clark College's ability to provide service for the PUAH program; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
