

ORDINANCE No. 188814

*Authorize a grant agreement with The Rosewood Initiative in an amount not to exceed \$64,800 to support their Community Resource Navigation Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Rosewood Initiative is a neighborhood space where residents can help the community as well as improve themselves. Rosewood builds capacity in the neighborhood by helping people learn useful skills and by connecting friends, partners and resources.
2. The Rosewood Initiative's mission is to connect and empower Rosewood neighbors to build a safe, prosperous, vibrant and inclusive community.
3. The Community Resource Navigation Program includes but is not limited to: --
 - Designing a referral system that meets the diverse needs of the Rosewood Community.
 - Hiring a resource navigator to implement a new referral program.
 - Training the resource navigator in local resources, trauma informed approach, and community health worker certification.
 - Assisting neighbors in accessing vital community resources, including housing assistance, health and wellness, equitable transit, and safety using the new referral program.
 - Researching and connecting to partner agencies for resources.
 - Creating community feedback loops to understand what services and programs are missing.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, with The Rosewood Initiative as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$64,800.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could result in a delay in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


