

ORDINANCE No.

*Authorize a grant agreement with The Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center plus Rosemary Anderson High School in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 for their Violence Intervention Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center (POIC) plus Rosemary Anderson High School (RAHS) is committed to the future Success of at-risk youth through the age of 25, providing the highest quality services in education, mentoring, family outreach, employment training and placement.
2. Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center has been creating opportunities for marginalized communities for nearly 50 years, through their mission of commitment to the future success of at-risk youth. Providing the highest quality of service in education, mentoring, family outreach, employment training and placement.
3. POIC's Violence Intervention Program is a partnership led by POIC, in conjunction with Multnomah County Health Department's Striving to Reduce Youth Violence Everywhere (STRYVE) program, Multnomah County Department of County Human Services' Defending Childhood Initiative (DCI) program, the City of Portland's Office of Youth Violence Prevention, and the City of Gresham.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:


- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, with The Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center plus Rosemary Anderson High School as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$15,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could result in a delay in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


