**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

This legislation will be in the form of a fiscal year 2017-2018, special appropriation grant to The Portland Industrialization Center plus Rosemary Anderson High School, in the amount of \$15,000. These funds will be used to support their Violence Intervention Program geared towards at-risk youth ages 16 -24.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

Funding for this grant is available in the FY2017-18 budget in the General Fund Special Appropriations.

**Community impacts and community involvement:**

This legislation will serve at-risk youth of color, between the ages of 16-24, through the facilitation of STRYVE's youth violence prevention and intervention program, providing positive behavior modification and self-awareness training (mindfulness training) and through peer to peer mentoring. Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center has been creating opportunities for marginalized communities for nearly 50 years, through their mission of commitment to the future success of at-risk youth. Providing the highest quality of service in education, mentoring, family outreach, employment training and placement. This legislation is consistent with the City's desire for educated youth, family outreach, employment training and placement.
