ORDINANCE No. 188826

* Authorize the Bureau of Environmental Services to reimburse property owner at 131 NE Holland St for sewer user fees paid to the City in the amount of \$4,376 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Sheri Smith (the Owner) purchased the property at 131 NE Hollard Street (the Property) on May 1, 1990. At that time, Sheri Smith became responsible for sewer user fees.
- Prior to July 1, 1991 all Portland residents within 100 feet of a sewer line paid sewer user fees, regardless of sewer connection status. From July 1, 1991 through June 30, 1993, sewer customers paid flat-rate user fees if their property was connected to the public sewer system. Beginning July 1, 1993, sewer customers were billed sewer user fees based on water consumption.
- In December of 2017 the Owner discovered, through the process of completing private
 property sewer repairs, that the property is not connected to the public sewer system. BES
 confirmed that the property is not connected to the public sewer by performing a standard dye
 test.
- 4. The Owner paid sewer user fees for the Property, to the City, in an amount estimated to be \$4,865.69 from July 1, 1991 to December 12, 2017. The Owner did not receive sewer service from the City for these user fees.
- 5. City Code section 17.36.090 A allows the Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services to authorize sewer adjustments for billing errors limited to the most recent three years of billing. BES issued a reimbursement of \$489.74 for three years (2014 2017) of sewer user fees to the Owner on January 4, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Bureau of Environmental Services reimburse Sheri Smith \$4375.95 in sewer user fees, the total of sewer user fees collected in error by the City from the Owner from 1991 - 2013.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to reimburse the Owner for funds that were collected in error. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
