ORDINANCE No. 188827

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the West Burnside Multimodal Project for an estimated \$1,949,125 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- West Burnside Street is on the Portland Bureau of Transportation's (PBOT's) High Crash Network, and as such has been prioritized by the City for Vision Zero safety investments.
- 2. In June 2016, PBOT completed the West Burnside Multimodal Study, which evaluated opportunities to improve safety and accessibility along and across West Burnside Street between 15th Avenue and 20th Avenue.
- 3. The West Burnside Multimodal Study recommended a preferred alternative design based traffic analysis and community engagement, which improves the intersection of W Burnside and 18th, 19th, and Alder, including upgraded traffic signals, a series of new pedestrian crossings, safer bike facilities, and an enhanced bus island with new street trees.
- Project design is now at 100% and PBOT is preparing for bidding the project for construction.
- 5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 17/18 and 18/19 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, as 100% plans and estimates are now completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00538 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to begin work during the construction season; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
