

## **ORDINANCE No. 188827**

\*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the West Burnside Multimodal Project for an estimated \$1,949,125 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. West Burnside Street is on the Portland Bureau of Transportation's (PBOT's) High Crash Network, and as such has been prioritized by the City for Vision Zero safety investments.
2. In June 2016, PBOT completed the West Burnside Multimodal Study, which evaluated opportunities to improve safety and accessibility along and across West Burnside Street between 15th Avenue and 20th Avenue.
3. The West Burnside Multimodal Study recommended a preferred alternative design based traffic analysis and community engagement, which improves the intersection of W Burnside and 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, and Alder, including upgraded traffic signals, a series of new pedestrian crossings, safer bike facilities, and an enhanced bus island with new street trees.
4. Project design is now at 100% and PBOT is preparing for bidding the project for construction.
5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 17/18 and 18/19 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, as 100% plans and estimates are now completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00538 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to begin work during the construction season; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


