# ORDINANCE No. 188830

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of Portsmouth-University Park Sewer Rehabilitation. Project No.E10335 for an estimated cost of \$4,110,000 (Ordinance)

### The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate approximately 8,200 feet of sewer main line in the north Portland neighborhoods of Portsmouth and University Park.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating or replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$4,110,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 17-18, CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center, WBS Element E10335.

### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer to competitively solicit and receive construction services bids for the Portsmouth-University Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project.
- b. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
