

ORDINANCE No. 188830

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of Portsmouth-University Park Sewer Rehabilitation. Project No.E10335 for an estimated cost of \$4,110,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate approximately 8,200 feet of sewer main line in the north Portland neighborhoods of Portsmouth and University Park.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating or replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$4,110,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 17-18, CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center, WBS Element E10335.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Chief Procurement Officer to competitively solicit and receive construction services bids for the Portsmouth-University Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project.
- b. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
