ORDINANCE NO. 188840

Authorize a contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. in the amount of \$749,190 for the N. Willamette Blvd. Bridge Main Replacement Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Water Bureau must retain the professional, technical, and expert services (PTE) of an engineering consultant to design and develop plans and specifications for a construction contract and provide construction support services to replace the existing 20-inch Cast Iron pipeline crossing the Willamette Blvd. Bridge.
- 2. The goal of the Willamette Blvd. Bridge Main Replacement Project (Project) is to eliminate the current deficiencies and increase overall resilience of the crossing by replacing the existing 20-inch main hung from the bridge with a 24-inch buried main.
- 3. The consultant selection was conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland (RFP No. 00000594). The evaluation committee reviewed the proposals and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. was deemed the most responsive and qualified proposer to perform the work on this Project.
- 4. The contract amount is \$749,190 with a contract term of 5 years. Funds are available in the FY 2017-18 Budget and will be requested in the FY 2018-19 through FY 2021-22 Budgets.
- 5. The estimated Oregon State certified Disadvantaged, Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Businesses (DMWESB) participation on this contract is \$147,614, or 20% of the total contract dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute on behalf of the City a contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. to design and develop plans and specifications for a construction contract and engineering support services for the N. Willamette Blvd. Bridge Main Replacement in a form in accordance with the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
