

ORDINANCE NO. 176184

* Authorize an intergovernmental agreement between the Portland Police Bureau and the Oregon National Guard. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On July 28, 1999 the City of Portland entered into an agreement with the Oregon National Guard (ORNG) whereby the ORNG supports the Police Bureau (PPB) in approved counterdrug missions.
2. That agreement did not establish the rank of the ORNG officer with the authority to authorize the ORNG personnel to carry firearms when specifically requested by PPB.
3. The ORNG wishes to designate the ORNG rank of Adjutant General as their officer with the authority to approve the carrying of firearms by ORNG personnel. ORNG personnel will continue to work without firearms unless the Police Bureau requests that they be armed for a specific mission.
4. The rest of the intergovernmental agreement remains unchanged.
5. The PPB wishes to continue to work with the ORNG in the counterdrug mission capacity. This ordinance will supercede contract 51218.

NOW, therefore, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to replace intergovernmental agreement number 51218 (attached as Exhibit B) between the City of Portland Police Bureau and the Oregon National Guard with the intergovernmental agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive the City of Portland and the Oregon National Guard of the mutual benefits of this agreement; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
