### ORDINANCE No. 176241

\*Authorize the Planning Bureau Director to execute an agreement with GeoVantage, Inc. for the provision of high-resolution, ortho-rectified, multi-spectral imagery services in the amount of \$90,000 (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Bureau of Environmental Services and the Endangered Species Program are engaged in various watershed and city-wide planning projects which require the use of high-resolution, multi-spectral imagery.
- 2. This imagery shall be used to identify various land covers: including impervious surfaces, vegetative cover, water bodies, and other types using advanced multi-spectral image analysis methods.
- 3. The cost-effective identification of these land cover types is critical to the success of various planning efforts, including River Renaissance, the Clean River Plan, the ESA program, BES CSO program, and Portland's remedial response to Superfund listing.
- 4. A formal RFP process has been conducted by the BES Systems Analysis Section. The selection committee recommends contract award to GeoVantage, Inc.
- 6. The established cost \$90,000. Funds are approved and available in the General Fund, FY 2001-02 Budget, Bureau of Planning, Center Code 510-81-802, Account No. 521000.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Planning Bureau Director and City Auditor to execute an agreement with GeoVantage, Inc. for the provision of high-resolution, ortho-rectified, multi-spectral imagery services in the amount of \$90,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants payable to GeoVantage, Inc. and chargeable to the General Fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of the time critical nature of this data collection effort for scheduled modeling and planning activities as part of River Renaissance, the Clean River Plan, the ESA program, BES CSO program, and Portland's remedial response to Superfund listing. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
