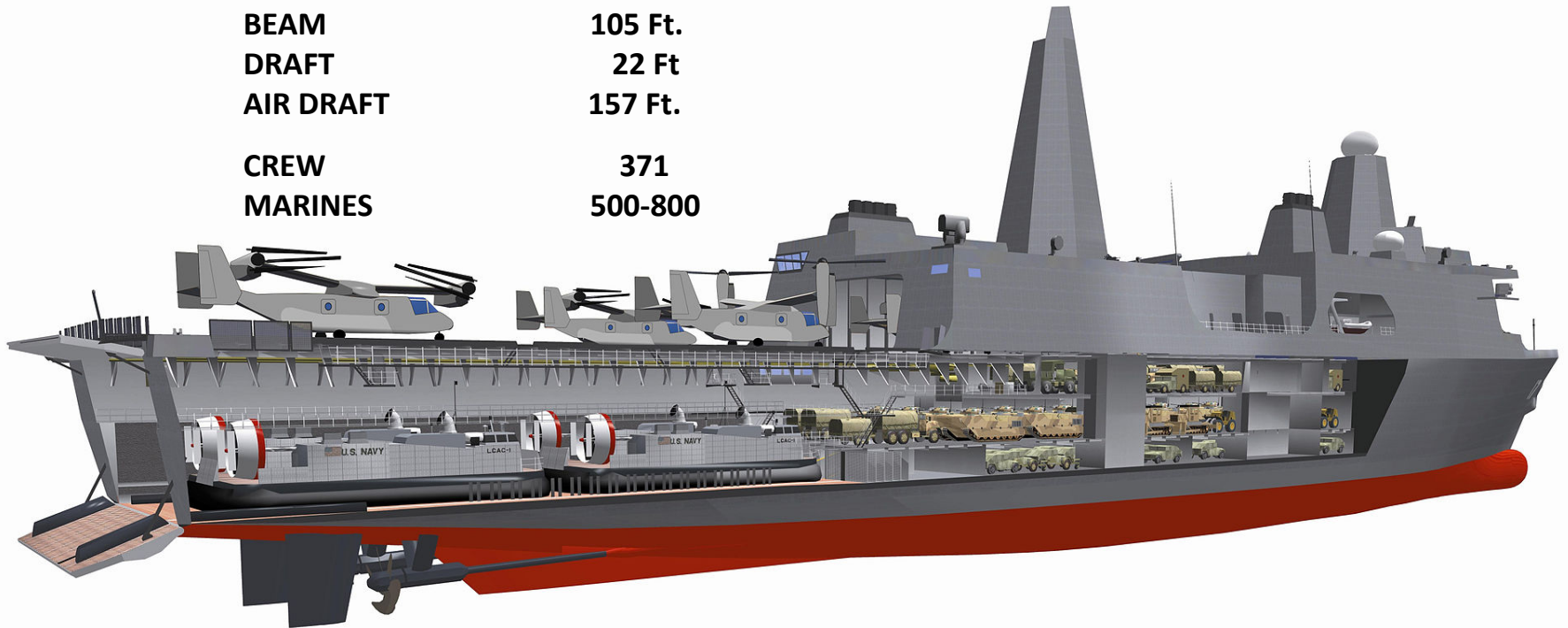

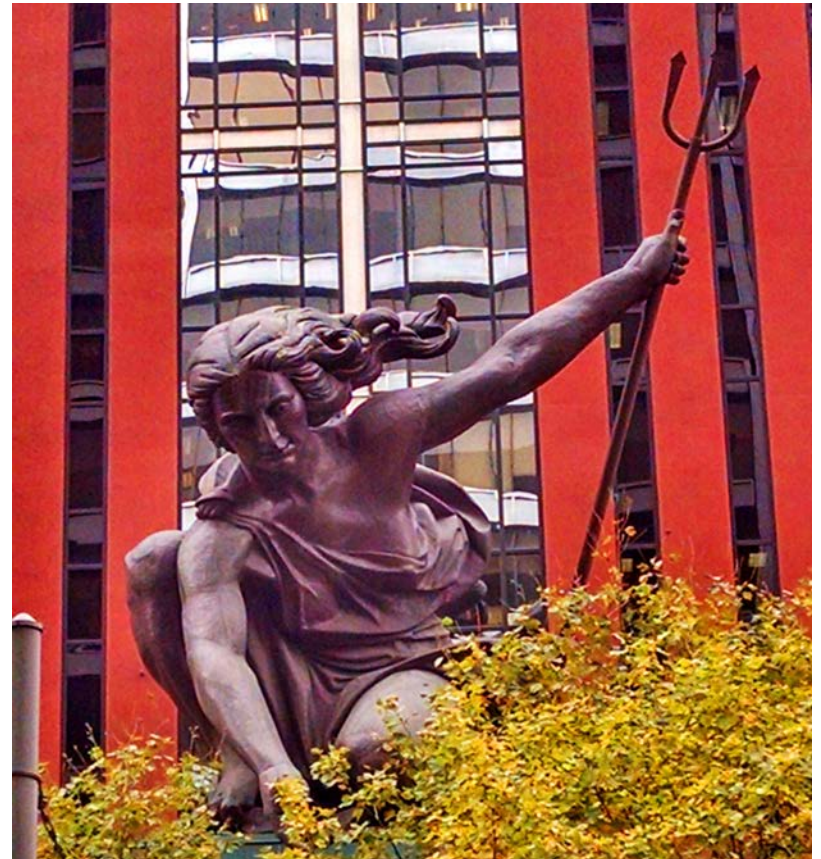


COMMISSIONING ACTIVITIES
