## ORDINANCE No.

\*Pay claim of Robert Blaschke in the sum of \$7,830 for bodily injury resulting from a motor vehicle collision with the Portland Police Bureau. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Robert Blaschke, through his insurance, State Farm, has filed a bodily injury claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Police Bureau on March 10, 2017.
- The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The
  investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in
  order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to
  compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$7,830.73 with the amount of \$2,830.73 still due to State Farm.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$2,830.73 made payable to State Farm Insurance.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this bodily injury claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
