## ORDINANCE No.

Amend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to pay the City up to \$4.8 million for design and construction services performed on the Sellwood Bridge Project (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30004901)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Multnomah County and the City of Portland entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) on July 22, 2015 (Ord. 187265) authorizing Multnomah County to pay the City up to \$3,600,000 for design and construction work performed on the Sellwood Bridge Replacement Project.
- 2. Multnomah County and the City of Portland wish to amend this IGA increasing the not to exceed reimbursement amount to the City of Portland from \$3,600,000 to \$4,800,000.
- 3. The term of the agreement will be extended until June 30, 2018.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an amendment on behalf of the City of Portland to Ordinance 187265 between the City and Multnomah County as outlined in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A in the amount of \$1,200,00 for a total amount not to exceed \$4.800.000.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge (or party authorized above to execute the IGA) is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
