Portland's Garbage, Recycling & Compost Collection System

"Commercial"

(Businesses and multifamily properties ≥5 units)

- Customers choose their hauler
- City administers rules, assists businesses
- City receives per-ton fee

"Residential curbside"

(single house up to four-plex)

- Haulers serve geographic territories through franchise system
- City sets rates, administers rules, assists residents
- City receives franchise fee (percent of revenue)

Residential garbage, recycling, and composting monthly rates for 35 gallon roll cart




