ORDINANCE No. 188863

*Pay bodily injury claim of Margaret Ayala in the sum of \$14,000 involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Margaret Ayala and her automobile insurer State Farm Insurance have filed a bodily injury claim against the City for injuries suffered in a vehicle collision involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation on October 14, 2015.
- 2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the Claim be compromised for the total sum of \$14,000.00 with the amount of \$14,000.00 still due, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$5,000 made payable to Margaret Ayala and a second check in the amount of \$9,000 made payable to State Farm Insurance.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.


