## **ORDINANCE No. 188867**

\* Authorize application and accept a grant in the amount of \$25,999 and appropriate \$12,000 for FY 2017-18 from the Oregon Department of Transportation Traffic Safety Division FY 2018 Safety Belt Grant program for sworn personnel overtime reimbursement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety
  Division (TSD) has notified the City that it will award a grant for the FY 2018
  Safety Belt Grant program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$25,999.31;
- 2. The Bureau wishes to apply for and accept the ODOT TSD 2018 grant award;
- 3. The Oregon Department of Transportation will reimburse the City a maximum of \$25,999.31 for sworn personnel overtime worked on safety belt traffic enforcement during the blitz periods established by ODOT TSD and at other times when additional traffic enforcement coverage is deemed appropriate as funds allow;
- 4. ODOT reimburses officer overtime at a rate of \$67.65/hour and sergeant overtime at a rate of \$77.80/hour;
- 5. Local match is required by matching straight-time enforcement hours at \$6,500, which will be funded by existing bureau General Fund appropriation;
- 6. The grant period is October 1 2017, through September 30, 2018; and
- 7. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOT TSD.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to ODOT TSD for a grant in the amount of \$25,999.31 and execute the grant agreement.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City the subsequent grant award in the amount of \$25,999.31 from ODOT TSD for the FY 2018 Safety Belt Grant program.

d. With the acceptance of the grant award, the FY 2017-18 budget will be amended as follows:

## **GRANTS FUND**

Fund - 217
Business Area - PL
Bureau Program Expenses - \$12,000

- e. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- f. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by ODOT TSD FY 2018 Safety Belt Grant program, OP-18-45-03 QQQ, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOT TSD. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
