ORDINANCE No. 188872

*Authorize an additional position under the Open and Accountable Elections Program within the Office of Neighborhood Involvement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1: The Council finds:

- 1. On December 14, 2016 Council adopted the Open and Accountable Elections Policy, adding Code Chapter 2.16.
- 2. The intention of the program is to amplify the voices of small dollar contributors during elections, and to allow candidates with modest means and from diverse backgrounds the opportunity to run for office.
- 3. On March 8th, 2018 through Executive Order of the Mayor, the Open and Accountable Elections Program was assigned to a Commissioner's office.
- 4. In order to hire a program director to oversee the program, a new position needs to be authorized in the Open and Accountable Elections Fund. Although the fund currently resides in the Office of Neighborhood Involvement, it is expected to move to Special Appropriations in the Spring Budget Monitoring Process.
- 5. The implementation of the program is well behind schedule to have the program available for the 2020 elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a) The number of authorized positions in the FY 2017-18 Revised Budget is hereby amended to include the following new positions:

Office of Neighborhood Involvement Fund – 214 Business Area – NI Authorized FTE – 1.0 Position Type – Regular

Adding this position will bring total authorized positions in the City to 6,436.38 FTE.

- b) Approval of this ordinance includes a technical budget adjustment to move \$100,000 from external materials and services to personnel within fund 214000 to fund the additional 1.0 FTE.
- c) The actions amending the FY 2017-18 budget contained in this ordinance are binding City policy.

Section 2. The Council declares than an emergency exists because delay in this action would prevent for the on implementation of the program in time for the 2020 election cycle; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
