Key Rate Factors

- Recyclable material sales revenue
- Labor and fuel costs as adjusted for inflation
- Garbage disposal costs

Less: Sale of Recyclables	\$0.27	\$2.18	\$1.91
Franchise Fee	\$1.46	\$1.59	\$0.13
Proposed Rate	\$29.25	\$31.80	\$2.55

*Rates in westside terrain area include an additional \$4.20 to account for productivity differences with eastside areas.





Proposed Monthly Rates

Primary Service Levels	Proposed Rate FY18-19	% Households Served
35-Gallon Can / Cart - Every 4 Weeks	\$24.25	5%
20-Gallon Can / Cart – EOW	\$27.15	8%
32-Gallon Can – EOW	\$31.80	9%
35-Gallon Cart – EOW	\$31.80	44%
60-Gallon Cart – EOW	\$37.65	24%
90-Gallon Cart – EOW	\$44.15	4%
