

ORDINANCE No. 188886

Authorize an Add Work Letter Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation related to sewer facility adjustments to be completed by the US26 (Powell Blvd) SE 122nd Ave to SE 136th Ave Project in the amount of \$12,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. ODOT's US26 (Powell Blvd) SE 122nd Ave to SE 136th Ave Project must make necessary adjustments to twelve City of Portland manhole assets.
2. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) requested the adjustments be done by ODOT at BES expense as part of said project.
3. The estimated cost is \$12,000.00. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017-2018 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Internal Order 9ESWW000003.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute an Add Work Letter Agreement with ODOT for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$12,000.00, provided the Agreement has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
