

Ordinance No 2117
An Ordinance
To prevent the use of beam-shooters

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Sec 1- That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons within the corporate limits of said City to use or cause to be used, or encourage the use of, any beam-shooter or other contrivance or invention used in shooting or throwing any beans stones pebbles or other substance or thing in or upon any street park, lane alley or other public place in said City.

Sec 2 Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of Sec 1 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon a conviction thereof before the Police Judge of said City shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$5 nor more than \$20 or by imprisonment not exceeding 10 days or both at the discretion of the Court.
