Authorize price agreements with CH2M HILL Engineers, Inc., Kennedy/Jenks Consultants Inc., Murraysmith, Inc., and WSP USA Inc. for professional engineering services for the continuation of the Large-Scale Sewer System Rehabilitation Program: Pipe Rehabilitation Phase 3, and Large Diameter Sewer Rehabilitation for a total of \$16,000,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) owns, operates and maintains more than 2,300 miles of pipe, 96 wastewater pump stations and 2 wastewater treatment plants. Such a large system necessitates continuous programmatic evaluation, repair, and improvement of facilities.
2. BES has identified a series of needs for structural rehabilitation of critical combined and sanitary sewers that are at the end of their economic life and have the highest consequence of failure.
3. The attached Agreements for Services are for the necessary work scope, costs, schedules and deliverables to provide investigation and predesign services, design documents, bidding phase assistance and design support during construction for sewer rehabilitation projects identified as part of the Large-Scale Sewer System Rehabilitation Program: Pipe Rehabilitation Phase 3 and Large Diameter Sewer Rehabilitation.
4. The consultant selection has been conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland (RFP No. 00000755). The consultant selection committee recommended that price agreements be awarded to four firms: CH2M HILL Engineers, Inc., Kennedy/Jenks Consultants Inc., Murraysmith, Inc., and WSP USA Inc.
5. The estimated cost for each price agreement is \$4,000,000, for a total cost of \$16,000,000 for a period of three years. The cost estimate level of confidence rating is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017-18 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services,
6. Work performed under these price agreements will be authorized via written Task Orders. Each negotiated Task Order shall include State of Oregon certified Disadvantaged, Minority, Women and Emerging Small Business (D/M/W/ESB) firms as subconsultants to the maximum extent possible. The aspirational goal for D/M/W/ESB utilization is 30%, and all consultants have committed to making good faith efforts towards achieving the goal.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute price agreements with CH2M HILL Engineers, Inc., Kennedy/Jenks Consultants Inc., Murraysmith, Inc., and WSP USA Inc., for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$4,000,000 for each price agreement.
- b. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute amendments to each price agreement that does not increase total compensation beyond twenty-five percent (25%) of the original price agreement amount.
- c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

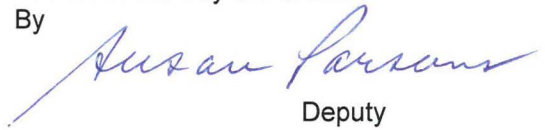

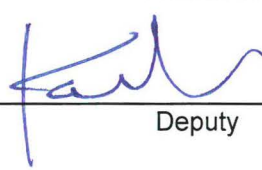
