### **Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

#### Purpose of Agenda Item:

To confirm the appointment of Claire Carder, Isa Dean, Alexandra Degher, Beth Rubin, Jai Singh, Sandra Walden and Christina Wienholz to the Community Involvement Committee for a term May 1, 2018 through April 30, 2021

#### History of Agenda Item/Background:

The Community Involvement Committee (CIC) is composed of 5 to 12 volunteer members who review and advise the way City staff engage with the public in land use and transportation planning. This is the first round of appointments to this new committee.

### **Financial and budgetary impacts:**

There are no financial or budgetary impacts.

### **Community impacts and community involvement:**

Chapter 2 of Portland's new Comprehensive Plan calls for the creation of a volunteer body to oversee the City's community involvement efforts for land use and transportation planning projects. The CIC will act in this role to review and advise City staff on their engagement with the public in land use and transportation planning projects and programs.

This round of applications were received in fall 2017, and 59 completed applications were received. The next round of selections will take place in 2019 and will be open to the general public. Anyone with an interest in the Community Involvement Committee is welcome to apply.
