Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This legislation will be in the form of a fiscal year 2017-2018, special appropriations grant to Home Forward, in the amount of \$21,900. These funds will be used to support their k'ching work experience, leadership development program.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Funding for this grant is available in the FY2017-18 budget in the General Fund Special Appropriations.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This legislation will fund Home Forward's k'ching work experience, leadership development program that is geared towards low-income, multicultural youth ages 11-15. Home Forward's primary mission is affordable housing; but they also have a long history of providing supportive services, both directly and through community partnerships. This program will provide work experience, combined with leadership development and community engagement. Youth will be placed as stipend volunteers in various organizations, all located within the greater New Columbia community in North Portland's Portsmouth neighborhood.
