

ORDINANCE No. 188913

*Authorize a grant agreement with LGBTQ Community Center Fund doing business as Q Center in an amount not to exceed \$17,087 to support the Q Center LGBTQIA+ Hate Crime Response and Supportive Services Training Initiative. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Q Center works for a better world by providing safe and affirming spaces of support, celebration, and opportunity for LGBTQIA+ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans (umbrella) Queer, Intersex, Asexual/Agender +other) people of all ages, races, genders, and abilities.
2. Q Center is a community hub, and facilitator of an LGBTQIA+-and-affirming community support network for Oregon and Southwest Washington. Through this network, Q Center works to support and advocate for the interests of their communities, interpersonally, institutionally, and politically.
3. Q Center serves a diverse LGBTQIA+ community with emotional support, safer space, recreation and referral to other services relevant to their safety and health. Together with improved resources there will be an increased outreach and training regarding hate crime response.
4. In a February 2015 survey, LGBTQ community members called for more empowered representation by trans women and people of color at Q Center. As a result of this focus, monthly visits to Q Center by people of color are up by nearly 300%. Q Center also earned the trust of Sankofa Collective NW, one of Portland's foremost LGBTQ black organization.
5. The FY2017-18 budget includes funding in the General Fund Special Appropriations for the above grant. The City now desires to make a grant to Q Center in an amount not to exceed \$17,087.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services, as authorized by Ordinance No. 188820 is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with Q Center, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$17,087.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget.




