### ORDINANCE No.

\*Authorize a grant agreement with REAP Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for their Solutions Program East Portland Expansion. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Since 2001 REAP emerged has one of the exemplary youth development program models in the State of Oregon. Their program staff work in schools and with youth and families on issues including leadership, development, discipline equity, academic enrichment, civic engagement and entrepreneurship. REAP has become a resource to business leaders, educators, elected officials, community advocates and parents. REAP brings students into a community of learning and leadership through programs that proactively ignite, elevate, and engage the student's voice. Their mission is to proactively, ignite, elevate and engage the next wave of leaders for the future, now.
- 2. REAP will use the funding in support of their Solutions Program East Portland Expansion in the David Douglas School District in East Portland. Solutions is a student driven leadership program targeting students during and after school, offering regular activities related to four curriculum models: Civic Engagement, Health, Business and Education.

### NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, with REAP Inc., a. as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$50,000.
- The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment b. chargeable to Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could result in a delay in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
