Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

In 2013, City Council granted a franchise to OHSU for telecommunications services, passed by Council as Ordinance No. 186386. OHSU has notified the City that it is seeking authority to provide the additional services of district heating and district cooling, electricity, water distribution, and non-potable water. The City and OHSU have negotiated a new franchise for a 10-year term to replace the 2013 franchise. To authorize the use of the City's right-of-way for these additional purposes, a new franchise grant of authority should be granted to replace the 2013 franchise. This franchise will supersede and replace the 2013 grant of authority to OHSU.
