


An Ordinance authorizing release of a water easement through Lot 10, Block 2, Glenada, to Carl and Grace L. Mumm, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:


Section 1. The Council finds that City of Portland presently owns a water easement through Lot 10, Block 2, Glenada; that said property is presently owned by Carl and Grace L. Mumm; that said easement has been abandoned by the City of Portland and the Chief Engineer of the Bureau of Water recommends that such easement be released to the owners; now, therefore, the Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized and directed to execute a quit claim deed to Carl and Grace L. Mumm, releasing the interest of the City of Portland in and to the water easement through Lot 10, Block 2, Glenada, Multnomah County, Oregon, said deed to be approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the city of Portland in this: In order that the deed specified in Section 1 of this ordinance may be given without further delay so that title to the specified property may be cleared; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
