Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- The ordinance will authorize a grant from Prosper Portland to the Portland Bureau of Transportation for the N Lombard Pedestrian Enhancement project.
- The project is necessary to enhance the pedestrian environment at key nodes of N Lombard Street, a major commercial corridor in north Portland.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

- The project is in PBOT current budget for capital improvement projects.
- No long term financial impacts or changes to City policy or budget are required.
- This action does not amend the budget.
- There are no negative impacts if action is not approved.

Community impacts and community involvement:

- In 2014, Prosper Portland and Portland Bureau of Transportation staff convened the Lombard Working Group, an approximately 25-member advisory body comprised of neighborhood residents and Lombard business owners to advise Prosper Portland and PBOT on priority improvements to the corridor. The Lombard Working Group's eight-month effort led to the 2015 Lombard Investment Strategy, which identified specific nodes for street improvements and recommended investments along the corridor to assist and preserve existing businesses.
- The eight-month community input process resulting in the Lombard Investment Strategy included public branding workshops, six walking tours, business outreach, a public open house, and a working group representing property and business owners that provided direct input.
- Most recently, on January 25, 2018, Prosper Portland and PBOT staff met with the North Portland Land Use Group, a committee representing a coalition of North Portland neighborhood organizations, to review project status, the partners' investment commitment, and next steps.
