*Pay property damage claim of Nguyet Le in the sum of \$25,514 involving the Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Nguyet Le has filed a property damage claim against the City for damages to her rental house that resulted from actions of the Portland Police Bureau on September 8, 2016.
- 2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services and the City Attorney's Office. The investigation indicates there is a risk the City may be found liable. In addition, the Committee on Claims has recommended payment. Therefore, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. The City Attorney's Office recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$25,514, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$25,514 made payable to Nguyet Le.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this property damage claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
