188955 ORDINANCE No.

*Authorize a grant agreement with Central City Concern, in an amount not to exceed \$47,500 for their community volunteer corps program. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The mission of Central City Concern (CCC) is to provide comprehensive solutions that help people end homelessness and achieve self-sufficiency. CCC meets this mission through innovative strategies that support personal and community transformation in the domains of housing, healthcare, additional treatment, and employment.
- 2. The community volunteer corps (CVC) program benefits more than 300 clients annually who are eligible to enroll in the service. Currently CVC is open to all CCC clients enrolled in housing, treatment, and select employment programs. Recently CVC began a small pilot project with Transition Projects to open the program to a small group of their clients. With additional transportation and equipment, CVC could be available to more clients in CCC's partner agencies. Currently the CVC is experiencing challenges associated with their growing referral base, increased community need for their volunteers, and deteriorating raingear, boots, and tools. City funding will allow the program to update its equipment and purchase tools to create a more comfortable and safe experience for participants.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services, as authorized by Ordinance 188820, is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, with Central City Concern as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$47,500.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could result in a delay in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
