ORDINANCE No. 188967 with Kenton Action Plan

*Authorize grant agreement totaling \$13,329 for Neighborhood Small Grants within the target area of North Portland Neighborhood Services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Neighborhood Small Grants Program provides neighborhood and community organizations an opportunity to expand their community-building capacity, attract new and diverse members and sustain those already involved.
- 2. This program has been adopted as part of the FY 18 ONI budget and is funded with a total of \$13,329 through City General Fund dollars.
- 3. Kenton Action Plan, dba North Portland Community Works, is a nonprofit organization working in collaboration with North Portland Neighborhood Services, the District Coalition office funded by ONI, to distribute small grants and provide civic engagement services within the target area of North Portland Neighborhood Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Director of the ONI and the City Auditor are authorized to execute a grant a) agreement with Kenton Action Plan totaling \$13,329 on behalf of the City in a form substantially in accordance with Exhibit A attached as follows:
- Amendments to the grant agreement may be agreed to and executed by the c) Director of ONI or her/his designee provided those amendments do not increase the fiscal risk to the City.
- d) The Director of the ONI and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said grant agreement from the Office of Neighborhood Involvement FY 18 general funds.

Section 2. The council declares an emergency ordinance exists in order to avoid interruption in the continuity of services to be provided, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
