GRANTEE will serve at least 30 youth from 6th to 12th grades with job readiness skills and academic support through the school year..
4. Section II 1bi shall include the following:

GRANTEE will provide at least 30 students from 6th-12th grades with financial readiness skills and academic support through GRANTEE'S after-school programming.
5. Section II 1c shall be replaced as follows:

GRANTEE will provide an athletic and skills-building mentorship opportunity for 100 6th – 12th grade students via SEI sports camps, including but not limited to basketball and soccer in partnership with community organizations (Portland Community College) and community members. GRANTEE will also partner with Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) for potential use of facilities and equipment.

- iv. Boxing: Staff will lead workshops at PP&R community centers on boxing basics and use healthy communication strategies to resolve conflict.
- v. Youth Empowerment Groups: Weekly groups offered to youth to provide a safe space to talk about their community, relationships, and family.


