TO THE COUNCIL:

The Treasury Division (Treasury) of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services in the Office of Management and Finance (OMF) is responsible for providing banking services to the City.

Banking services refers to depository accounts and services, disbursement services, branch services, online account access and reporting, and other banking services. The City is required by State law to deposit funds only in depository institutions approved by the Oregon State Treasurer's Public Funds Collateralization Program.

The estimated cost for banking services over a period of five (5) years is approximately \$675,000. The contract will be paid for by Treasury out of Treasury's budget.

On September 27, 2017, City Council passed Ordinance 188615 authorizing a competitive solicitation for the purchase of banking services for an estimated amount of \$800,000.

On October 3, 2017, the Chief Procurement Officer advertised RFP No. 00000748 and five (5) proposals were received and opened on October 30, 2017. All five (5) proposals were deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation. The proposals were evaluated and scored by a panel of evaluators including a member of the Minority Evaluator Program. The City issued a Notice of Intent to Negotiate and Award a price agreement to Wells Fargo Bank N.A., on December 11, 2017. No protests were received.

Wells Fargo Bank N.A. has a current business tax registration and is in compliance with all other City contracting requirements. Treasury's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this agreement is "High" as there is good historical information regarding costs paid by the City for these services.

Awarding a price agreement to Wells Fargo Bank N.A. will allow the City to perform banking services transactions and continue to provide excellent service to customers and the public. It is requested that City Council authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to execute a five-year price agreement with Wells Fargo Bank N.A., for a not-to-exceed amount of \$675,000.
