


Victory Day Celebration/Commemoration



The Portland City Council approved the Portland-Mutare Sister City relationship December 18, 1991 and as a non-profit organization, PMSCA has worked to promote good will and the exchange of ideas, goods, culture and friendship between the people of Portland, Oregon and Mutare, Zimbabwe. We strive to learn from our differences, celebrate our similarities and nurture our interconnectedness.

Since 1991, citizens from Portland and Mutare have made trips back and forth, learning from and working with each other. Our group has sent computers, partially covered teacher salaries, mailed 1200 eyeglasses, built a clinic, funded 2 ambulances, helped fund a car for rural hospice health outreach, funded a mother's shelter, clothing, textbooks, toys, school supplies, generators, musical instruments, sports uniforms, phones, heaters, radios, school fees, plus so much more. Recently, we agreed to fund bed pans and wheelchairs for hospice patients and funding for materials that deaf students will use to make and sell feminine products.





PSSCA assists in promoting and coordinating delegation visits to and from Suzhou in cooperation with local institutions such as PSU's Center for Urban Studies, PSU's Confucius Institute, Travel Portland, Lan Su Chinese Garden, Port of Portland, Prosper Portland, Portland Art Museum, Mark Spencer Hotel, our nine sister city schools and fabulous support from Chido Dhliwayo and Sydney Odell with the City of Portland's Office of International Relations as well as from Jin Siyan and Bruce Chen from the Suzhou Foreign Affairs Office.



Director Zhang Jian of the Suzhou Municipal Planning Bureau led a delegation of nine urban planning professionals from Suzhou to meet with the Portland's Planning Bureau to learn about Portland's development plans as a well as Portland restoration and historic preservation program. 

Meeting with the Mayor of Suzhou

Mayor Wheeler meets Mayor Li Yaping of Suzhou. This is a traditional meeting whereby both mayors provide a profile of their city, past, present and future.

A signing of a proclamation took place between the two cities outlining opportunities for future cooperation.

The proclamation reaffirmed the two cities longstanding sister city relationship in honor of our 30th year anniversary.



Visit to the Singapore Suzhou Industrial Park

The SIP began in 1994 as a bilateral project for Singapore to share industrialization experiences with China and was backed by former Singapore prime minister Lee Kuan Yew and late Chinese leader Deng Xiaoping.

The project aims to encourage innovation and entrepreneurship, and to attract high-tech industries, especially software-focused information technology and biotechnology industries.

The SIP is home to majority of Suzhou's expatriates and the base for Fortune 500 giants such as Samsung, UPS and Motorola. There are some 25,000 companies, of which 91 are Fortune 500 firms.





Travel Portland Luncheon

Jeff Miller, President and CEO of Travel Portland and Jeff Hammerly, Senior Manager of International Tourism hosted a luncheon for some 40 Suzhou tourism officials.

Executive Director of the Lan Su Chinese Garden Lisa James as well as Brian Ferriso, Executive Director of the Portland Art Museum represented two of our tourism destinations.

Immediately after the luncheon a seminar was hosted for the Suzhou tourism officials on Portland as a world class destination.

Visit to the Port of Taicang

Kristen Leonard, Chief Public Affairs Officer represented the Port of Portland on the delegation visit to the Port of Taicang

Taicang Port, which is located at the south bank of the Yangtze River estuary, is a nationally recognized artery port for container transportation at the north wing of the Shanghai International Navigation Center, and also the No.1 foreign trade port deemed as a key project by Jiangsu province.

It has 56 berths of different sizes, including 29 at 10,000-t





Visit to Suzhou Garden Development Company

The Lan Su Chinese Garden was designed by the Suzhou Landscape Architect Institute and built by their Garden Development Company almost twenty years ago.

The Portland delegation had the pleasure of visiting the Suzhou Development Company. Lisa James, Executive Director of Lan Su Chinese Garden has engaged the company to assist in a present restoration program to be completed in time for the Garden's 20th anniversary in 2020.



Interview with the Mayor

The Delegation visit to Suzhou was covered extensively by JiangSu Broadcasting Corporation and local print media.

Mayor Ted Wheeler was quoted as beginning the interview by saying, "Coming to Suzhou I have the feeling of being at home. Suzhou is a garden city with a beautiful environment."

The interview took place in the Master- of-Nets Garden, sister city garden to Lan Su Chinese Garden.

Tree Planting Ceremony

According to Suzhou press accounts, Mayor Li Yaping said in his speech, "Suzhou and Portland for more than 30 years, the two sides have been involved in the economic and trade, culture, arts, education, tourism, youth exchanges and many other fields in fruitful cooperation. Planting this camphor tree, not only commemorate the 30 years of friendship, but also looks forward to the next 30 years of long-term development to bare more fruit."



Visit to Lida Middle School

The Portland delegation visited the Lida Middle School which is the Suzhou Sister City School to Hosford Middle School. Kojo Hakan is Curriculum Specialist, PPS Mandarin Immersion Program and teacher of Mandarin.

Kojo leads the CRR (China Research Residency) program which is a two-week program to Portland's sister school in Suzhou for 8th grade immersion students. While in Suzhou students engage in field studies, home stays, and produce a bilingual video documentary of their experiences.

Kojo here is sharing with the delegation the school's fruit, vegetable and flower garden which the students manage themselves.



Discover Oregon's Green Technologies

Suzhou business professionals and governmental officials, including Suzhou Vice Mayor Ms. Jin Jie, were invited on behalf of Business Oregon, Prosper Portland, the City of Portland and the Portland-Suzhou Sister City Association to learn about Oregon's cutting-edge green technologies and practices.

The breakfast seminar was organized by Sunun Setboonsarng, Global Trade Specialist for Business Oregon and Catherine Zhou, CEO EcoKMC, Business Oregon's partner in Suzhou.





 collaborative brews happening. We hope to celebrate with the Dutch brewers the results of these collaborations.






