Ordinance No. 188988

Extend term of right-of-way use agreement granted to T-Mobile West Corporation, Inc. for mobile telecommunications services (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 185790).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In 2012, the Council approved a right-of-way use agreement for T-Mobile West Corporation, Inc. (T-Mobile) to build and operate wireless facilities within the City's streets for providing mobile telecommunications services. Ordinance No. 185790.
- 2. The Council amended the right-of-way use agreement in 2013 and again in 2017. Ordinance Nos. 185956 and 188392. The 2017 amendment extended the term to June 30, 2018.
- 3. City staff need time to develop new right-of-way use agreements for mobile telecommunications carriers because small cells were not addressed by previously negotiated agreements. The City recently concluded a small cell pilot program for attachments on non-city-owned poles in the right-of-way. Staff is analyzing data from the pilot program and will draft recommended policy and process changes to wireless siting in the right-of-way to accommodate small cell, and future, technology.
- 4. Furthermore, City bureaus are developing a wireless master plan for City-owned assets to establish policies for leasing City property to attach wireless infrastructure and related aesthetic standards. The wireless master plan will apply to non-city-owned poles when appropriate.
- 5. City staff recommends that the Council extend T-Mobile's existing right-of-way use agreement by one year.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Ordinance No. 185790 is hereby amended to extend the term of the right-of-way use agreement, continuously and without interruption, to June 30, 2019.
- b. All other terms and conditions of the right-of-way use agreement shall remain the same and unchanged.
- c. On or before the thirtieth (30th) day after this Ordinance becomes effective, T-Mobile shall file in the Office of the Auditor of the City of Portland a written acceptance of this Ordinance, executed by T-Mobile, subject to approval, as to form, by the City Attorney. Any failure on the part of T-Mobile to file such written acceptance within such time shall be deemed an abandonment and rejection of this Ordinance, and this

Ordinance shall thereupon be null and void. Such acceptance shall be unqualified and shall be construed to be an acceptance of all the terms, conditions and restrictions contained in this Ordinance.
