

## ORDINANCE No. 188991

\* Extend contract with VCA Antech, Inc., dba Southeast Portland Animal Hospital to June 30, 2023 and increase by not-to-exceed amount to \$175,000 for Veterinary Care of Police Bureau Canines (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30003480)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City through the Portland Police Bureau (PPB), works with highly trained police canines.
2. In 2013, the City contracted with VCA Antech, Inc., dba SE Portland Animal Hospital (SPAH), to provide veterinary care for the PPB canine units.
3. The current contract will expire on July 1, 2018.
4. The total not to exceed amount for the contract is currently \$75,000 for the five year period of the contract; this amendment would increase the not to exceed amount to \$175,000 for the next five fiscal years.
5. SPAH would like to adjust their cost for services to reflect current costs.
6. Sufficient funding resides in on-going Police Bureau General Fund appropriation; the increase of dollars on this contract does not obligate the City to spend funds.
7. It is beneficial to the City and community that this agreement may be authorized as quickly as possible to avoid a lapse in services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to amend an agreement between the City and VCA Antech, Inc. dba SE Portland Animal Hospital as outlined in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police and the Project Manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of the Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of compensation or increase the City's financial risk.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in executing the contract will deprive the City of the benefits of the continuity of SPAH's services to its canines. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
