## ORDINANCE No. 189010

\*Authorize a grant agreement with El Programa Hispano Catolico in an amount not to exceed \$48,363 for their puentes academic mentorship program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The mission of El Programa Hispano Catolico is three-fold: to increase access to autonomy and self-determination for the Latino community, to provide support to community members as they identify and define their own empowerment, and to promote understanding of the enormous diversity within our Latino community.
- 2. The puentes academic mentorship program will support Latinx youth transitioning between middle and high school in East Portland, who are considered academically and socially at risk. These youths are deeply affected by the racialized poverty crisis that is deepening in their community. The 2014 Poverty in Multnomah County report issued by the Department of County Human Services provides stark evidence of the detrimental consequences of exposure to poverty on young people. According to the report, childhood poverty is connected to many grave issues, including poor health and lower academic attainment (pg. 47). The report also states that children with long term exposure to poverty and racism have considerable impacts on brain development and mental health, two issues that are deeply linked to academic achievement.
- 3. The Puentes program is currently funded by the Oregon Youth Development Council and The Collins Foundation. Funding supports mentors stationed at Reynolds High School and Gresham High School. City of Portland funding would allow the grantee to add mentorship FTE at David Douglas High School and HB Lee Middle School. This funding will increase El Programa Hispano Catolico's capacity to reach at risk students in the City of Portland.

### NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services, as authorized by Ordinance 188820, is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, with El Programa Hispano Catolico as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$48,363.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could result in a delay in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
