ORDINANCE No. 189013

Accept a \$188,000 award from Metro Nature in Neighborhoods Capital Grants Program for improvements at Leach Botanical Garden (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Metro has notified the City of Portland that it will award Portland Parks & Recreation a Nature in Neighborhoods Capital Grant in the amount of \$188,000 for the redesign and construction of the Upper Garden of Leach Botanical Garden.
- 2. Portland Parks & Recreation will additionally provide \$376,000 in matching funds from Systems Development Charges.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a Nature in Neighborhoods Capital Grant from Metro for the redesign and construction of Leach Botanical Garden in the amount of \$188,000.
- b. The grant amount \$188,000 will be appropriated in FY 2018/19 and 2019/20 budget.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of Portland Parks & Recreation of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Metro, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.
